



PUBLIC NOTICE FOR SCHOLARSHIPS FOR STUDENTS ENROLLED IN HEALTHCARE PROFESSIONS 2021/2022 ACADEMIC YEAR

PUBLIC NOTICE FOR THE GRANTING OF THREE (3) SCHOLARSHIPS FINANCED BY HUMANITAS UNIVERSITY. SCHOLARSHIPS ARE RESERVED FOR EU CITIZENS OR AND THE LIKE WHO INTEND TO ENROLL IN THE FIRST YEAR OF FIRST CYCLE DEGREES IN HEALTHCARE PROFESSIONS IN THE 2021/2022 ACADEMIC YEAR

INTRODUCTION

Humanitas University believes that deserving and motivated students should be supported in pursuing their academic and professional ambitions, so it has decided to finance three (3) scholarships reserved for EU citizens or the like who intend to enroll in the first year of First Cycle Degrees in Healthcare Professions in the 2021/2022 academic year.

Art. 1. Types and Amount of Scholarships

The three (3) scholarships available are subdivided into

- Three (3) scholarships **fully covering** university fees financed by **Humanitas University**, of which:
 - I. **One** (1) scholarship reserved for students enrolled in the **Physiotherapy Degree Program**;
 - II. **Two** (2) scholarships reserved for students enrolled in the **Nursing Degree Program**, regardless of the selected campus.

The amount of the three (3) scholarships is as follows:

- **Humanitas University** scholarship: from € 1,500.00 to € 5,000.00, according to the income bracket the student will be assigned to.

Scholarships will be paid out for each year of the program until the degree, according to the criteria established in article 3 of these Regulations.

As specified in article 4 of these Regulations, Humanitas University will take on itself the taxes due to the Inland Revenue office for the scholarships granted.

The university fees due by the students enrolled in the Humanitas University Degree Programs in Healthcare Professions vary according to the student's contribution bracket (Tables 1 and 2). The

bracket is assigned according to the Economic and Financial Situation Index, according to the provisions of the University's Regulations on University Fees and Contributions.

Contribution brackets and university fees established for students of Healthcare Professions at Humanitas University.

Consequently, the scholarship amount and the university contributions to be paid are defined as follows (Tables 3 and 4):

Art. 2. Requirements, Participation Methods and Awarding Criteria

Competition for scholarships is open for candidates who:

- rank among the top 10 in the Physiotherapy admission test ranking;
- rank among the top 20 of the Nursing admission test ranking, regardless of the selected campus¹;

Participation Method

Qualified candidates will be contacted by email, and will have to send the documents listed below to info@hunimed.eu, indicating “**Humanitas University Scholarship**”, by September 17, 2021:

- motivation letter;

¹ For the purpose of granting the scholarships, the 20 highest scores achieved by candidates who indicate Nursing as their first choice, are considered, regardless of the selected campus.

- certificate stating the mark earned in the high school final certificate (*diploma di maturità*);
- ISEE 2021 certificate.

Candidates who have not sent this documentation by the above-mentioned deadline **may not compete** for the scholarship awarding.

Granting criteria

Scholarships will be granted based on the following parameters: outcome of the admission test, high school final mark, ISEE (Equivalent Financial Situation Index) 2021 certificate.

A score will be determined for each parameter according to the following criteria (Table 5):

Outcome of the admission test	Score achieved
High school final marks*	$[(\text{Mark} - 60) / (100 - 60)] * 100$
ISEE 2021 certificate**	0 to 50 points

* *An equivalent calculation formula will be used for candidates with a foreign diploma.*

***The score is assigned as follows: 50 points for an ISEE between 0 and 15,000.00 €; 35 points for an ISEE between 15,000.01 and 25,000.00 €; 15 points for an ISEE between 25,000.01 and 50,000.00 €; 0 points for an ISEE not lower than 50,000.01 € or not submitted.*

The total score achieved by the candidate will be determined by the total scores relevant to the above listed parameters, to be determined according to the established criteria.

The maximum achievable score is 300 points.

In case of a tie, the candidate who achieves the best score in the admission test gets the top ranking in the scholarships award list.

Registration

Qualified candidates will be considered as **enrolled under reservation** until the scholarship award list is published and will not lose the registration right consequent to the execution of the admission test. The payment of the first installment will be not required at this stage.

After the **publication of the scholarships award list**, beneficiary and non-beneficiary candidates may exercise their right to enroll, by and not later than the terms indicated in the email received from info@hunimed.eu, by paying the amount due as indicated in the public notice, which varies according to the indications in Tables 1, 2, 3 and 4.

Art. 3 Requirements for the Renewal of the Scholarship

The candidates beneficiary of scholarships for the 2021/2022 academic year have the right of renewal for the subsequent years of the program, until they earn their degree, provided, at the end of each year, they comply with the following requirements:

- have achieved and maintained a weighted average equal to or greater than 25/30.
- have earned all educational credits (CFUs) provided for by the study plan.

Beneficiary candidates must earn the required CFU's **within the September test session** (last exam session of the academic year).

If, in September of every year, beneficiary candidates have not earned the required CFUs or the weighted average of their exam scores is below 25/30, they will lose the benefit and will have to pay the university fees duly applied for pursuant to the Regulations on University Fees and Contributions.

Beneficiary candidates must earn their Degree in 3 years. However, an additional 6-month term, for the only purpose of earning the Degree, is granted for maintaining the benefit. After this term, the beneficiary candidate must pay the university contributions according to the provisions of the Regulations on University Fees and Contributions.

The scholarship **cannot be cumulated** with any other scholarship paid out by Humanitas University.

Art. 4 Tax Implications of the Scholarship

In order to **guarantee a net tax exemption** equivalent to the amount specified under article 1 of these Regulations, for each scholarship **Humanitas University undertakes to cover the tax burdens** provided for by the rules in force

Please note that **scholarships are calculated as employment income** pursuant to article 50 of Presidential Decree no. 917/86. Therefore, beneficiary students will receive a specific pay-slip and **will have to take autonomous care of tax fulfillment and duties** arising from the enjoyment of the above-mentioned sums.
