



RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE MEDTEC SCHOLARSHIPS FOR 2020-2021 ACADEMIC YEAR

REGULATION FOR THE AWARD OF SEVEN (7) SCHOLARSHIPS FUNDED BY FONDAZIONE ROCCA, ABMEDICA, JOHNSON & JOHNSON AND HUMANITAS UNIVERSITY. SCHOLARSHIPS ARE RESERVED FOR EUROPEAN CITIZENS AND EU-EQUATED CITIZENS WHO APPLY FOR THE FIRST YEAR OF THE SINGLE CYCLE DEGREE COURSE IN MEDICINE AND SURGERY – MEDTEC SCHOOL IN THE ENGLISH LANGUAGE FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2020-2021 (Class LM-41)

FOREWORD

Convinced that deserving and motivated students must be supported in pursuing their academic and professional aspirations, Fondazione Rocca, ABMedica, Johnson & Johnson and Humanitas University have decided to fund seven (7) scholarships reserved for EU citizens and EU-equated citizens who wish to enroll in the first year of the Single Cycle Degree Course in Medicine and Surgery – MedTec School in English in the academic year 2020-21 (class LM-41).

Art. 1. Categories and Value of Scholarships

The seven (7) available scholarships are divided into:

- One (1) **full** scholarship funded by *Fondazione Rocca*;
- One (1) **full** scholarship funded by *ABMedica*;
- Four (4) **full** scholarships funded by *Humanitas University*;
- One (1) scholarship funded by *Johnson and Johnson*.

The value of the seven (7) scholarships is determined by:

- **Full Scholarships: from € 10,000.00 to € 20,000.00** depending on the tuition bracket to which the student will be assigned;
- **Johnson & Johnson Scholarship: from € 10,000.00 to € 13,000.00** depending on the tuition bracket to which the student will be assigned.

Scholarships will be awarded for each academic year until graduation, according to the criteria established in Art. 4 of this Regulation.

The academic costs for students enrolled in the Degree Course in Medicine and Surgery – MedTec School of Humanitas University vary according to the student's Tuition Bracket (Table 1), which is assigned on the basis of the University Fees Regulation.

Tuition brackets and academic costs for the Medicine and Surgery – MedTec School Students of Humanitas University.

Art. 2. Requirements, Methods of Participation and Award Criteria

Candidates who:

- Have obtained a final mark of greater than or equal to 90/100 in secondary school. An equivalent score is required for candidates with a non-Italian secondary school diploma. ¹
- Are ranked within the first 20 positions in the Entrance Exam Ranking List.

Scholarships are reserved for EU citizens and EU-equated citizens.

How to participate

The first 20 ranked in the Entrance Exam Ranking List must send the following documents **by 15 September 2020** to the address info@hunimed.eu, indicating in the subject "**MedTec Scholarship**":

- Motivation Letter and *curriculum vitae* in the English Language;
- Certificate with final mark of secondary school.

All **candidates who have not sent this documentation** by the above deadline **will not be able to compete** for any of the scholarships.

Award criteria

¹ If the candidate has completed an International Baccalaureate Diploma, refer to the **Conversion Table in Attachment A**.
If the candidate has completed a European Baccalaureate, his/her final mark is considered equivalent to the Italian final mark.

The scholarships will be assigned according to the following criteria: score of the Entrance Exam, final mark of secondary school, outcome of the motivational interview.

For each parameter, a score will be determined according to the following criteria (Table 4):

Table 4

Parameter	Score Calculation Criteria
Entry test result	Exam score
Final mark of secondary school*	$[(\text{Final mark} - 60)/(100 - 60)] * 400$
Outcome of the motivational interview	From 0 to 600 points

**For candidates with non-Italian diplomas, an equivalent calculation formula will be used to determine score.*

The total score achieved by the candidate will be calculated by the sum of the scores relative to the parameters listed above, determined according to the established criteria.

The maximum achievable score is 2000 points.

In case of equal scores, the highest position in the ranking list is assigned to the candidate who obtains a better exam score.

On the basis of the ranking list, full scholarships will be awarded to candidates with higher positions.

Candidates will be called to hold an interview with a Special Scholarship Commission after September 15, 2020. The interview is aimed at determining the motivation and aptitudes of the candidates towards the study of the courses included in the study plan of the degree course.

Candidates can hold the interview in person at Humanitas University (Via Rita Levi Montalcini 4, Pieve Emanuele, Milan - Italy) or by videoconference.

The dates of the interviews, held in the **English language**, will be communicated to the candidates immediately following the publication of the Ranking List of the Entrance Exam.

Enrollment

The **eligible candidates** will automatically be considered **pre-enrolled** until the Scholarship Winners are announced. During this time, the eligible candidates will not be required to complete the payment of the First Tuition Installment.

Following the **Announcement of Scholarship Winners**, all eligible candidates that were held as **pre-enrolled** will then be able to **complete their enrollment** no later than the deadline indicated via email from info@hunimed.eu. First Tuition Installment amount, which varies according to the contents of Tables 1, 2 and 3, will also be indicated within the same email.

Art. 3. The Special Scholarship Commission for the Allocation of Humanitas University Scholarships

To ensure the impartiality of the procedure for assigning Humanitas University scholarships, Humanitas University will appoint a special scholarship Commission composed of the President of the Degree Course in Medicine and Surgery – MedTec School - who will also be the Commission President - by a member of the faculty and a member of the University's administrative staff.

Art. 4 Requirements for Renewal of Scholarships

Scholarship winners of the Academic Year 2020-2021 are entitled to the renewal of the scholarship in the following years of the degree course, up until graduation, if, at the end of each year, they meet the following requirements:

- Achieved and maintained a weighted grade average equal to or greater than 27/30.
- Achieved a minimum annual number of University Credits as specified in the following table (Table 5):

1° year	As per the procedure described in art. 2
2° year	52, to be obtained by the end of the first year
3° year	107, to be obtained by the end of the second year
4° year	159, to be obtained by the end of the third year
5° year	222, to be obtained by the end of the fourth year
6° year	284, to be obtained by the end of the fifth year

- Scholarship winners must obtain the required credits by the end of the exam session in September (last exam session of the academic year);
- In the event that, in September of each year, the scholarship winners do not reach the University Credits specified in Table 5 or do not maintain a weighted grade average of equal to or greater than 27/30, the student will lose the scholarship award and will have to pay the academic tuition fees regularly required in accordance with the Fees Regulation;
- Scholarship winners must obtain the Degree in Medicine and Surgery in 6 years of study. However, an additional 6-month period, for the sole purpose of obtaining the degree, is granted. After this period of time, the student will have to pay the academic tuition fees regularly required in accordance with the Fees Regulation.
