



**CALL FOR APPLICATIONS FOR ADMISSION TO
“UNIVERSITY ADVANCED PROGRAMME IN LASER DENTISTRY”**

A.A. 2019/2020

Art. 1.1. – University advanced programme

Humanitas University is offering a University advanced training programme in "**Laser dentistry**". This six-month advanced programme is taught in English entitling the student to 20 ECTS (University Formation Credits).

Scientific Director: Prof. Roly Kornblit**

Coordinator: Prof. Roberto Weinstein***

The course is composed of three modules of three-day meetings and a final four-day meeting, and by e-learning sections between the meetings. The course focuses on theoretical and applied clinical knowledge of laser use in all aspects of dental surgery and medicine. Additional aspects will focus on the practical use of lasers and the compilation of clinical case presentations.

Didactic activities are scheduled to start in **April 2020**.

The number of places offered is 20.

A minimum of 10 participants is required to activate the university Advanced Programme.

The University reserves the right to verify whether conditions exist for expanding or restricting the aforementioned number of participants.

Art. 1.2. - Course objectives

The university advanced programme in Laser Dentistry is designed to provide evidence-based core knowledge in laser use in dentistry and to refine practical skills. Emphasis is placed on the integration of this course into the on-going practice of dentistry for each participant and the future



benefit of laser use for dental patients. Course participants are expected to reach a level of competence that is consistent with an experienced laser user.

Art. 2 - General admissions requirements

Applicants may submit an application for participation in the selection procedure if they meet the following requirements:

- Degree in Medicine and Surgery (LM - 41) or Dentistry (LM - 46) or an equivalent qualification awarded by a foreign university;
- Specialty degree in Odontostomatology or Maxillofacial Surgery or an equivalent qualification awarded by a foreign university.

The equivalence of the foreign academic qualification will be assessed by the examining commission on its compliance with current legislation in the field, in Italy and in the country where the qualification was issued, in addition to international treaties and/or agreements on the recognition of qualifications. The University, therefore, requires a *Declaration of value* statement issued by the Italian diplomatic representatives in the country of issue. The Declaration of Value will have to be hand in by June 30th 2020, certifying that:

- the qualification was issued by the competent authority in the country of attainment;
- the admission requirements to the programme (basic education);
- the qualification entitles the holder to practise the medical profession in the country of issue;
- the duration of the degree programme;
- the authenticity of the signature on the qualification, and the legitimacy of the qualification itself (in the absence of such a certification of authenticity, the legalization of the certificate issued by the competent Authorities is required).

In case the Declaration of Value is not provided to Humanitas University by the indicated deadline, it will not be possible to complete the course and receive the final attendance certificate.

Art. 3 – Admission and selection

A ranking list will be drawn up according to the total number of points assigned on the basis of qualification evaluation (academic titles, years of working experience, previous experience in Laser Dentistry).

The ranking list will be publish online by March 16th 2020.



Art. 4 - Application for admission to the selection procedure

The application for admission to the selection procedure must be submitted **no later than February 29th 2020**, following the online procedure described below:

1. Register at the Humanitas University website at <https://humanitas.esse3.cineca.it/>
(after registration the candidate will receive a username and password to access reserved areas of the site);
2. Enter the reserved area of the site using the username and password and complete the application by attaching the documentation listed below in .pdf format (each file must not exceed 2 MB):
 - a) Application form (Annex A) completed, dated and signed;
 - b) Curriculum vitae and studiorum complete with clinical experience in Laser Dentistry;
 - c) Copy of a valid identification document (front and back).

You may change the details entered only prior to application submission.

3. Following submission of the application, the system automatically generates an email confirming receipt of the application and requests payment of a contribution by credit card for the selection costs, set at € 50.00 (fifty / 00 euro).

This fee is non-refundable and must be paid no later than the deadline for submitting applications for admission. **The application is considered completed only after payment of the contribution for selection costs.** It is possible to verify the payment by accessing the reserved area of the site with your credentials.

Failure to submit one or more documents referred to in Art. 4 point 2, involves exclusion from the selection procedure.

Art. 5 – Ranking order

Eligible candidates are admitted to the university advanced programme according to the ranking order up to the number of available places. The list will be published by the end of **March 16th 2020** on the University website at <https://www.hunimed.eu/course/university-advanced-programme-in-laser-dentistry/>.

The publication is valid for all purposes as **official notification** to the winning candidates.



Candidates admitted to the Course will no longer be eligible to do so if they do not register within the time set for enrolment as per point 6. In this case, the next candidate will take their place according to the ranking order.

In the event that one or more candidates withdraw from the enrolment procedure, any places made available will be offered to subsequent candidates ranked according to merit until they are all filled.

Art. 6 - Enrolment

Candidates admitted to the professional Course must follow the enrolment procedure outlined at: <https://humanitas.esse3.cineca.it/> by March 23rd 2020, under penalty of forfeiture. The registration fee is € 5,000.00 inclusive of costs for the course diploma and stamp duty. Payment can be made in two instalments:

- € 2,500.00 on enrolment;
- € 2,500.00 by June 30th 2020.

Cancellation does not give the right to a refund of the contributions paid.

Art. 7 - Attendance and award of qualification

Attendance equal to or higher than 75% is mandatory. Attending classes and passing the final exam entitles the student to 20 ECTS (University Formation Credits) and the award of a certificate of attendance and completion of a university advanced programme in Laser Dentistry (Decree 22 October 2004, n.270).

Art. 8 - Forfeiture of benefits and causes of exclusion

The Administration reserves the right to carry out checks and pursuant to art. 75 of the D.P.R. 445/2000, the declarant shall forfeit entitlement to any benefits ensuing from the provision issued as a result of false statements.

Art. 9 - Processing of personal data

Pursuant to Legislative Decree n.196 / 2003 regarding the protection of personal data, and EU Regulation n.679/2016 and subsequent amendments, the University undertakes to respect the confidential nature of the information provided by the candidates: all data provided will be processed only for the purposes of the call for applications and University matters, in compliance with the provisions in force.
