



### **Italian Courses and activities: Medicine and Surgery- Academic Year 2021-2022**

#### **Year 1**

**Induction starter course** - 40-hour basic general Italian course held in September, both online and face-to-face with e-books.

**General and Medical Italian** – 14-hour courses\* (A1+/A2- levels), Semester I and II, for a total of 28 hours. Structured courses with specialised programme, test every semester to monitor progress.

#### **Year 2**

**General and Medical Italian** – 14-hour courses\* (A2/A2+ level), Semester I and II, for a total of 28 hours. Structured courses with specialised programme with a strong focus on Medical Italian to prepare for clerkships. Test every semester to monitor progress.

#### **Year 3**

**General and Medical Italian** – 12-hour courses\* (A2+/B1- Level), Semester I and II, for a total of 24 hours. Structured courses with specialised programme and on demand modules with a strong focus on Medical Italian to prepare for clerkships. Test every semester to monitor progress.

#### **Year 4 and 5**

**Medical writing workshops** - Medical writing workshops (B1-B2 level) to support students in their clerkships for a total of 10 hours in Semester I and II.

#### **Extra Italian activities**

**On-demand course:** 20-hour on demand basic Italian course available online on Edu platform, for late incoming international students or to support students who have difficulties with Italian.

**Intensive courses – Refresh** – 12-hour refresh courses (A1-A2 and A2-B1 levels) before the start of the 2021-22 academic year. The course will be a mix of general and medical Italian.

**Support course:** 10-hour course (A1-A2 level), Semester II, for students who fall behind with Italian to revise and practise content of Year 1 and 2 courses.

**PLIDA Certification:** 10-hour preparation course during II Semester to prepare for PLIDA international certification (currently B1-B2 level).

**Open badge system** – awarded to students on achieving a specific level of Italian (available for some courses).

**Electronic Portfolio-** available for students to monitor their progress in Italian from October 2021.

**E-tandem-** language exchange project among students of HUNIMED (coming in 2022).
