



THE REGULATION FOR THE ASSIGNATION, IN THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2017-18, OF ONE (1) SCHOLARSHIP RESERVED TO PARTECIPANTS TO NATURAL SCIENCES OLYMPICS (OLIMPIADI DELLE SCIENZE NATURALI) WHO ARE EU CITIZENS AND EU EQUATED CITIZENS FOR THE ONE-CYCLE DEGREE COURSE IN MEDICINE AND SURGERY WITH LIMITED ACCESS (Class LM-41) IN ENGLISH AT HUMANITAS UNIVERSITY

## **FOREWORD**

The official source of the Regulation is IL REGOLAMENTO PER IL CONFERIMENTO, NELL'ANNO ACCADEMICO 2017-18, DI UNA (1) BORSA DI STUDIO RISERVATA AI PARTECIPANTI ALLE OLIMPIADI DELLE SCIENZE NATURALI FINALIZZATA ALL'ESONERO PARZIALE O TOTALE DAI CONTRIBUTI ACCADEMICI (DI SEGUITO ESONERO) MEDIANTE LA VALUTAZIONE DEI REQUISITI DI MERITO CONSEGUITI NELLA PARTECIPAZIONE ALLE OLIMPIADI  
L'ESONERO E' RISERVATO AI CITTADINI COMUNITARI O EQUIPARATI CHE INTENDANO IMMATRICOLARSI AL CORSO DI LAUREA MAGISTRALE A CICLO UNICO IN MEDICINA E CHIRURGIA IN LINGUA INGLESE (Classe LM-41).

This document is provided for the convenience of international students. In the event of disputes, the parties should refer only to the document in Italian.

### **Art. 1 Number of Scholarships**

For the academic year 2017-18, the number of the Scholarships reserved to the participants to the Natural Sciences Olympics is established as 1. The Scholarship is reserved to EU citizens and EU equated citizens.

EU equated citizens are:

- Citizens holding a European citizenship together with a citizenship of a country not belonging to the European Union.
- The citizens of United Kingdom Norway, Iceland, Liechtenstein, Switzerland, the Republic of San Marino.
- Non-EU citizens holding a residence permit in Italy for employment or self-employment, for family reasons, political asylum, asylum for humanitarian or religious reasons.
- Non-EU citizens legally resident in Italy from at least one year in possession of a Secondary School Diploma obtained in Italy.

- Non-EU citizens, resident anywhere who hold diplomas from Italian schools abroad or foreign or international schools having bilateral agreements or special regulations for the recognition of qualifications and who satisfy the general conditions required to be admitted to study in Italy.
- Refugees.
- Diplomatic personnel accredited to International Organizations in Italy, Italian State, Vatican State and their dependant family members.

### **Art. 2 Value and use of the scholarships**

The value of the scholarship is established in 10.000 € for the academic year 2017-18. The granted amount will be exclusively used as a fee waiver to reduce the tuition fee amount required for the degree course in Medicine and Surgery.

The scholarship will be automatically renewed, annually, until graduation if the student:

- maintains an average of grade of 28/30;
- completes a minimum annual number of University credits (CFU) as specified in Art. 7.

### **Art. 3 The Commission for scholarships assignation**

To assure the fairness of the procedures of scholarships assignation Humanitas University will appoint a commission composed by Professors of Humanitas University.

The Chairman of the Commission is the President of the Degree course in Medicine and Surgery.

### **Art. 4 Eligible Candidates**

Eligible candidates are those:

- who participated in the Natural Sciences Olympics (Olimpiadi delle scienze naturali), positioning themselves within the first 20 places in the national ranking;
- who register for Humanitas University admission test to access the first year of the degree course in Medicine and Surgery, obtaining a place in the ranking within the first 80 positions.
- Those candidates enrolled after being placed in the reserve list will not be considered for the scholarship.

No candidates being in possession of the above mentioned requirements, the scholarship will not be assigned.

**Art. 4 Selection procedures**

The scholarship will be assigned according the following procedures:

- Eligible candidates will be considered those in possession of the requirement reported in Art. 4.
- Candidates must send to the e-mail address **info@hunimed.eu** the following documents by August 31<sup>th</sup> 2017:
  - Candidate's name and surname;
  - High School of the candidate (address and name of the school)
  - Position in the ranking of Natural Sciences Olympics (Olimpiadi delle scienze naturali)
- The documents reported above and received by the University within the established date (August 31<sup>th</sup> 2017) will be evaluated after the publication of the ranking list of the admission test (September 20<sup>th</sup> 2017).
- Eligible Candidates will be required to sit for an interview with the Commission. Candidates can seat the interview presenting themselves at Humanitas University premises (Via Manzoni, 113 Rozzano, Milano – Italy) or by videoconference.
- The date of the interview will be communicated by mail to the eligible candidates.

**Art. 6 Assignment of the Scholarships**

The Scholarship will be assigned on the basis of the position in the national ranking of Natural Sciences Olympics (Olimpiadi delle scienze naturali) provided that:

- the position is within the first 20 positions of the ranking of the Natural Sciences Olympics (Olimpiadi delle scienze naturali);
- the candidate will participate in the Humanitas University admission test obtaining a place within the first 80 positions in the ranking.

**Art. 7 Requirements for Scholarships renewal**

Students awarded with the Scholarship for the academic year 2017-18 are also entitled for the future years of the Degree Course in Medicine and Surgery, until they graduate if they:

- Maintain an average of grade of 28/30.
- Complete a minimum annual number of University credits (CFU) as specified in the table below (Table 1).

**TABLE 1**

<b>Degree course in Medicine and Surgery</b>	<b>CFU Required</b>
1th year scholarship	According the procedure specified above
2nd year scholarship	51, to be acquired within 1th year
3rd year scholarship	86, to be acquired within 2nd year
4th year scholarship	162, to be acquired within 3rd year
5th year scholarship	219, to be acquired within 4th year
6th year scholarship	261, to be acquired within 5th year

- Awarded students must complete the required CFU within the month of September (last exams term of the academic year).
- In case the student doesn't match the CFU requirements of Table 1, the scholarship will be withdrawn and the student will have to pay the full amount of tuition fees starting from the following academic year.
- The awarded student is expected to complete the Degree Course in Medicine and Surgery within 6 years. However for the purpose of the present call an extra time of 6 months is granted for the completion of the Degree Course. After that, the scholarship will be withdrawn and the student will have to pay the full amount of tuition fees for the extra years.
