

THE REGULATION FOR THE ASSIGNATION, IN THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2015-16, OF ONE (1) SCHOLARSHIP RESERVED TO PARTECIPANTS TO NATURAL SCIENCES OLYMPICS (OLIMPIADI DELLE SCIENZE NATURALI) WHO ARE EU CITIZENS AND EU EQUATED CITINZENS FOR THE ONE-CYCLE DEGREE COURSE IN MEDICINE AND SURGERY WITH LIMITED ACCESS (Class LM-41) IN ENGLISH AT HUMANITAS UNIVERSITY

FOREWORD

This document is provided for the convenience of international students. In the event of disputes, the parties should refer only to the document in Italian.

Art. 1 Number of Scholarships

For the academic year 2015-16, the number of the Scholarships entitled in honor of Paola Einaudi reserved to EU citizens and EU equated citizens is established as one (1).

EU equated citizens are:

- Citizens holding a European citizenship together with a citizenship of a country not belonging to the European Union.
- The citizens of Norway, Iceland, Liechtenstein, Switzerland, the Republic of San Marino.
- Non-EU citizens holding a residence permit in Italy for employment or self-employment, for family reasons, political asylum, asylum for humanitarian or religious reasons.
- Non-EU citizens legally resident in Italy from at least one year in possession of a Secondary School Diploma obtained in Italy.
- Non-EU citizens, resident anywhere who hold diplomas from Italian schools abroad or foreign or international schools having bilateral agreements or special regulations for the recognition of qualifications and who satisfy the general conditions required to be admitted to study in Italy.
- Refugees.



• Diplomatic personnel accredited to International Organizations in Italy, Italian State, Vatican State and their dependant family members.

Art. 2 Value and use of the scholarships

The value of the scholarship is established in $10.000 \in$ for the academic year 2015-16. The granted amount will be exclusively used as a fee waiver to reduce the tuition fee amount required for the degree course in Medicine and Surgery.

The scholarship will be automatically renewed, annually, until graduation if the student:

- maintains an average of grade of 28/30;
- completes a minimum annual number of University credits (CFU) as specified in Art. 7

Art. 3 The Commission for scholarships assignation

To assure the fairness of the procedures of scholarships assignation Humanitas University will appoint a commission composed by Professors of Humanitas University.

The Chairman of the Commission is the President of the Degree course in Medicine and Surgery.

Art. 4 Eligible Candidates

Eligible candidates are those:

- who participate in the Natural Sciences Olympics (Olimpiadi delle scienze naturali), positioning themself within the first 20 places in the national ranking;
- who register for Humanitas University admission test to access the first year of the degree course in Medicine and Surgery, obtaining a position in the ranking which entitles them to enroll to Humanitas University in the first enrollment term (deadline October 2, 2015). Those candidates enrolled after being place in the reserve list will not be considered for the scholarship.

No candidates being in possession of the above mentioned requirements, the scholarship will not be assigned.

Art. 4 Selection procedures

The scholarship will be assigned according the following procedures:

- Eligible candidates will be considered those in possession of the requirement reported in Art. 4.
- Candidates must send to the e-mail address **info@hunimed.eu** the following documents by August 28th 2015:
 - ➤ Candidate's name and surname;
 - ▶ High School of the candidate (address and name of the school)

> Position in the ranking of Natural Sciences Olympics (Olimpiadi delle scienze naturali)

- The documents reported above and received by the University within the established date (August 28th 2015) will be evaluated after the publication of the ranking list of the admission test (September 22th 2015);
- Eligible Candidates will be required to sit for an interview with the Commission. Candidates can seat the interview presenting themself at Humanitas University premises (Via Manzoni, 113 Rozzano, Milano Italy) or by videoconference;
- The date of the interview will be communicated by mail to the eligible candidates.
- Eligible Candidates not selected for the scholarships, who have enrolled to Humanitas University will be reimbursed of the first installment in case of withdrawal within November 13th 2015.

Art. 6 Assignation of the Scholarships

The Scholarship will be assigned on the basis of the position in the national ranking of Natural Sciences Olympics (Olimpiadi delle scienze naturali) provided that

- the position is within the first 20 positions of the ranking in descending order;
- the candidate registers to Humanitas University admission test to access the first year of the degree course in Medicine and Surgery, obtaining a position in the ranking which entitles them to enroll to Humanitas University in the first enrollment term (deadline October 2, 2015). Those Enrolled after being place in the reserve list will not be considered for the scholarship.

Art. 7 Requirements for Scholarships renewal

The student awarded with the Scholarship for the academic year 2015-16 are also entitled for the future years of the Degree Course in Medicine and Surgery, until they will graduate if they:

- Maintain an average of grade of 28/30.
- Complete a minimum annual number of University credits (CFU) as specified in the table below (Table 1).

Degree course in Medicine and Surgery	CFU Required
1 th year scholarship	According the procedure specified above
2 nd year scholarship	51, to be acquired within 1 th year
3 rd year scholarship	86, to be acquired within 2 nd year
4 th year scholarship	162, to be acquired within 3 rd year
5 th year scholarship	219, to be acquired within 4 th year
6 th year scholarship	261, to be acquired within 5 th year

TABLE 1

- Awarded student must complete the required CFU within the month of September (last exams term of the academic year).
- In case the student will not match the CFU requirements of Table 1, the scholarship will be withdrawn and the student should pay the full amount of tuition fees starting from the following academic year.
- Awarded student is expected to complete the Degree Course in Medicine and Surgery within 6 years. However for the purpose of the present call an extra time of 6 months is granted for the completion of the Degree Course. After that, the scholarship will be withdrawn and the student should pay the full amount of tuition fees for the extra years.
