

REGULATION FOR THE ASSIGNATION OF FOUR (4) HUMANITAS UNIVERSITY MERIT-INCOME SCHOLARSHIPS RESERVED TO EU CITIZENS AND EU EQUATED CINTIZENS FOR THE ONE-CYCLE DEGREE COURSE IN MEDICINE AND SURGERY WITH LIMITED ACCESS (Class LM-41) IN ENGLISH AT HUMANITAS UNIVERSITY

FOREWORD

In the belief that talented and motivated students, who are not in affluent economic conditions, deserve to be supported in pursuing academic e professional aspirations, Humanitas University has decided to fund four (4) Humanitas University Merit-Income Scholarships

The official source of the Call for Applications for EU and equated citizens is REGOLAMENTO PER IL CONFERIMENTO, NELL'ANNO ACCADEMICO 2016-17, DI QUATTRO (4) ESONERI HUMANITAS UNIVERSITY FONDATI SU MERITO E REDDITO. GLI ESONERI SONO RISERVATI AI CITTADINI COMUNITARI O EQUIPARATI CHE INTENDANO IMMATRICOLARSI AL CORSO DI LAUREA MAGISTRALE A CICLO UNICO DI MEDICINA E CHIRURGIA IN LINGUA INGLESE (Class LM-41).

This document is provided for the convenience of international students. In the event of disputes, the parties should refer only to the document in Italian.

Art. 1 Number of Scholarships

For the academic year 2016-17, the number of Humanitas University Merit-Income Scholarships reserved to EU citizens and EU equated citizens is established as four (4).

EU equated citizens are:

- Citizens holding a European citizenship together with a citizenship of a country not belonging to the European Union;
- The citizens of Norway, Iceland, Liechtenstein, Switzerland, the Republic of San Marino;
- Non-EU citizens holding a residence permit in Italy for employment or self-employment, for family reasons, political asylum, asylum for humanitarian or religious reasons;
- Non-EU citizens legally resident in Italy from at least one year in possession of a Secondary School Diploma obtained in Italy;
- Non-EU citizens, resident anywhere who hold diplomas from Italian schools abroad or foreign or international schools having bilateral agreements or special regulations for the recognition of qualifications and who satisfy the general conditions required to be admitted to study in Italy;
- Refugees;

- Diplomatic personnel accredited to International Organizations in Italy, Italian State, Vatican State and their dependant family members.

Art. 2 Value and use of the scholarships

The value of each scholarship is established in 7.000 € for the academic year 2016-17. The granted amount will be exclusively used as a fee waiver to reduce the tuition fee amount required for the degree course in Medicine and Surgery.

The scholarship will be automatically renewed, annually, until graduation if the student:

- maintains an average of grade of 28/30;
- completes a minimum annual number of University credits (CFU) as specified in Art. 7.

Art. 3 The Commission for scholarships assignation

To assure the fairness of the procedures of the scholarships assignation Humanitas University will appoint a commission composed by Professors of Humanitas University and professionals in the pedagogic field.

The Chairman of the Commission is the President of the Degree course in Medicine and Surgery.

Art. 4 Eligible Candidates

Eligible candidates are the ones holding the following requirements:

- minimum score of High School Diploma of 90/100, or equivalent for those holding a non-Italian High School Qualification;
- Admission Test Raking Position within the best 35 places.

Candidates in possession of the above mentioned requirements will be automatically considered for the scholarships. No additional application is required. Candidates will be automatically considered for Humanitas University Scholarships.

Art. 5 Selection procedures

The four (4) awarded scholarships will be assigned according to the following procedures:

- eligible candidates will be considered those in possession of the requirements reported in Art. 4;
- candidates must send to the e-mail address **info@hunimed.eu** the following documents by August 28th 2016:

- Motivation letter and Candidate's Curriculum vitae (*Résumé*) written by the candidate;
 - Transcript of grades of the last three years of education;
 - High School Diploma Final Grade;
 - Two Presentation letter(s) written by teachers or relevant persons (if any);
 - Tax forms and the other documents required for the ISEP income category assignation (See University Fee Regulation);
- the documents reported above and received by the University within the established date (August 28th 2016) will be evaluated after the publication of the ranking list of the admission test (September 23th 2016);
 - eligible candidates will be required to sit for an interview with the Commission; candidates can seat the interview at Humanitas University premises (Via Manzoni, 113 Rozzano, Milano – Italy) or by videoconference;
 - the date of the interview will be communicated by mail to the eligible candidates.

Art. 6 Assignment of the Scholarships

The Scholarships will be assigned on the basis of a score ranging from 0 points to 1000 points and based on the following formula:

$$\left(\frac{(35 - \text{Candidate Ranking Position})}{(35-1)} \times 300 \right) + \left(\frac{(\text{High School Diploma grade} - 90)}{(100 - 90)} \times 300 \right) + \left(\text{Commission Interview Score 0-400 points} \right)$$

Candidates belonging to the first, second and third ISEP index category according to the “University Fee Regulation for the academic year 2016/2017” will be entitled of an extra 200 points to be added to the score obtained based on the above formula.

Candidates must be aware that the scholarships assignment will not be merely based on the admissions test ranking position and/or the High School Diploma Grade. As stated above, Candidates must seat an interview with the Commission. The Interview aims at evaluating the aptitude and the motivation of the candidates for the medical studies and profession. Furthermore, the Commission will evaluate the documents sent by the candidate. After the interview, the Commission will deliver an overall evaluation of the candidate assigning to each candidate a score ranging from 0 points to 400 points.

Art. 7 Requirements for Scholarships renewal

The students awarded with the Scholarships for the academic year 2016-17 are also entitled for the future years of the Degree Course in Medicine and Surgery, until graduation, if they:

- maintain an average of grade of 28/30;
- complete a minimum annual number of University credits (CFU) as specified in the table below (Table 1):

TABLE 1

Degree course in Medicine and Surgery	CFU Required
1 th year scholarship	According the procedure specified above
2 nd year scholarship	51, to be acquired within 1 th year
3 rd year scholarship	86, to be acquired within 2 nd year
4 th year scholarship	162, to be acquired within 3 rd year
5 th year scholarship	219, to be acquired within 4 th year
6 th year scholarship	261, to be acquired within 5 th year

- awarded students must complete the required CFU within the month of September (last exams term of the academic year);
- in case the student doesn't match the CFU requirements of Table 1, the scholarship will be withdrawn and the student will have to pay the full amount of tuition fees starting from the following academic year;
- awarded students are expected to complete the Degree Course in Medicine and Surgery within 6 years; however, for the purpose of the present call an extra time of 6 months is granted for the completion of the Degree Course; after that, the scholarship will be withdrawn and the student will have to pay the full amount of the tuition fees for the extra years.
