



**PUBLIC CALL FOR APPLICATIONS TO
ADVANCED POSTGRADUATE MASTER IN
EPIDEMIOLOGY FOR CLINICAL RESEARCH**

AY 2018/2019



Art. 1 – Learning objectives of the Professional Master

Humanitas University, in collaboration with the Department of Medical Sciences of the Università degli Studi di Torino) and IRCCS Humanitas, will offer the Professional Master in EPIDEMIOLOGY FOR CLINICAL RESEARCH in the academic year 2018/2019.

The aim of the Master is to promote the application of quantitative methods for translational medicine to the study of clinically relevant research questions and to improving patient care.

The Master is intended primarily for physicians and researchers in clinical and preclinical areas who wish to learn more about how to plan, carry out and analyse epidemiological investigations.

The Master, coordinated by Prof. Elio Riboli, Professor of Public Health at Humanitas University and Director of the School of Public Health, lasts one year and is conducted in English. The Master will be taught by an international faculty.

The maximum number of places available is 15. The minimum number for the activation of the Master is defined as 10.

The educational activities are spread over 7 weeks from November 2018 until December 2019. Attendance to all lessons and activities is compulsory.

Attendance of at least 75% of activity hours and a passing mark on the final test will result in 60 CFU (university credits) and a Certificate of Attendance and Completion will be awarded.

Art. 2 – General admission requirements

Applicants must have a medical specialty certificate (DM 509/99) or master's degree (DM 270/2004) or an equivalent qualification awarded by a foreign university in one of the following:

- Biology (6/S - LM-6)
- Medical, veterinary, pharmaceutical biotechnology (9/S - LM-9)
- Pharmacy and industrial pharmacy (14/S - LM-13)
- Medicine and Surgery (46/S - LM-41)

Preference is given to those applicants holding a medical specialty certificate and/or a Ph.D., or equivalent, i.e. certified experience in clinical or translational research.



Art. 3 – Selection process

Admission to the Master will take place per a public call for qualifications and possible interview. Applicants will be ranked per the evaluation criteria established by the Commission, nominated by Chancellor's Decree.

The Commission's evaluation will take into consideration the applicants' Curriculum Vitae et Studiorum, professional experience and proven aptitude for clinical and translational research.

In the event of a tie, the last place available will be awarded to the younger candidate.

If one or more applicants should withdraw, their places will be awarded to the subsequent applicants on the ranking, until all places have been awarded.

Art. 4 – Admission application

The admission application must be submitted by **10 September 2018** per the online procedure below:

1. Register at Humanitas University website: <https://humanitas.esse3.cineca.it/Home.do> (once registered, the applicant will receive a username and password to access the reserved area of the website);
2. Enter the reserved area using the username and password received upon registration and complete the application, attaching the documents in PDF listed below (each file must not exceed 2 MB):
 - a) Application (Attachment 1) completed, dated and signed;
 - b) Brief Curriculum Vitae et Studiorum;
 - c) Copy of a valid document of identification.
 - d) list of scientific publications and/ or congress speaker.

The declarations made in the admissions application (Attachment 1) have the same legal value as certifications as per the D.P.R. 445/2000.

Information entered can be modified until the moment of submission of the application.

Art. 5 – Admissions ranking

Applicants will be admitted to the Professional Master per ranking order until the number of places available has been reached. The ranking will be posted on the Humanitas University website at <https://www.hunimed.eu/it/corsi/epidemiologia-per-la-ricerca-clinica/>

This ranking posting has all the validity of an official notification of applicants admitted.

Any applicant admitted to the Master who has not enrolled by the deadline will be excluded. In such case, the next applicant per the ranking will take his/ her place.



Art. 6 - Enrolment

Those applicants admitted to the Master must enrol per the procedures set out at <https://humanitas.esse3.cineca.it/> within the terms posted on the Master website under penalty of forfeiture. The enrolment fee is € 6,000.00 (with accommodation at the new Humanitas University Student House € 7,000.00). The contribution includes the expenses for the issue of the original Master's degree, stamp duty, teaching materials and the annual license for the STATA software.

The enrolment fee can be paid in two instalments: the first (€ 3,000) by the enrolment deadline, and the second (€ 3,000) by 10 March 2019.

Should a student withdraw from the Master before 25% of the Master has been completed, the first applicant on the ranking who was not admitted will take his/ her place. Withdrawal from the Master does not entitle that student to reimbursement of fees.

Art. 7 - Forfeiture of benefits and reasons for exclusion

Under Article. 75 of the D.P.R. 445/2000, should the Administration find, on the basis of appropriate checks, that any statement made by the applicant is not truthful, the declarant shall forfeit any benefits arising from provisions made based on false declarations.

Art. 8 - Treatment of personal information

In accordance with Legislative Decree no. 196 of 30 June 2003 and subsequent amendments, Humanitas University undertakes to respect the confidential nature of the information provided by the applicants. All information will be used only for purposes connected with and instrumental to the selection process and with the management of relations with the University, in compliance with current regulations.

Art. 9 - Head of the selection process
