



REGULATION FOR THE ASSIGNATION OF ONE (1) HUMANITAS UNIVERSITY
SCHOLARSHIP RESERVED TO PARTICIPANTS OF THE HUMANITAS UNIVERSITY
FEBRUARY 2019 PREPARATION WEEK PROGRAMS

FOREWORD

In the belief that talented and motivated students deserve to be supported in pursuing academic and professional aspirations, Humanitas University has decided to fund one (1) Scholarship reserved to High School Students who participate in the Humanitas University February 2019 Preparation Week programs.

This document is provided for the convenience of international students. In the event of disputes, the parties should refer only to the document in Italian.

Art. 1. Value of the scholarship

The number of scholarships reserved to students participating in the Humanitas University February 2019 Preparation Weeks is established as one (1). The value of the scholarship is established in 10.000 €. The scholarship will be automatically renewed, annually and until graduation, if the student will meet the requirements specified in art. 5

The scholarship will be exclusively used as a fee waiver to reduce the tuition fee amount required for the degree course in Medicine and Surgery.

For the degree course in Medicine, tuition fees shall be paid according to the income category to which students are assigned on the basis of the family income (please see University fee regulation).

Income category and required tuition fees for Humanitas University Medical Students are reported below (Table 1):

Students awarded with the scholarship shall pay reduced tuition fees as following (Table 2):

Art. 2. Requirements and evaluation criteria

Candidates eligible to apply for the scholarship are those:

- participating to the Humanitas University February 2019 Preparation Weeks ;
- sitting the simulation test at the end of each February Preparation Week.

The simulation test will be a computer based multiple-choice test. Test questions will be as follows:

- Logical reasoning (11 questions)
- Biology (9 questions)
- Chemistry (6 questions)
- Physics and Mathematics (4 questions).

Simulation test program will be as specified in “**CALL FOR APPLICATIONS FOR EU AND EQUATED CITIZENS TO THE ONE-CYCLE DEGREE COURSE IN MEDICINE AND SURGERY WITH LIMITED ACCESS (Class LM-41) IN ENGLISH AT HUMANITAS UNIVERSITY**”

The scholarship will be granted to the candidate achieving the highest simulation test score if she/he will be included in the top 80 positions of Humanitas University admissions test ranking.

Art. 3. The Commission for scholarship assignation

To assure the fairness of the procedures Humanitas University will appoint a commission composed by the Dean of the Medical School, a member of the faculty and a member of the University management.

The Chairman of the Commission is the Dean of Medical School.

Art. 4. How to apply

Candidates participating in the Preparation Week and sitting the final simulation test will be automatically considered eligible to apply for the scholarship.

The candidate awarded with the scholarship will be invited for a welcoming interview with the President of the Medical School.

The interview will be scheduled after the publication of Humanitas University admissions test ranking list.

Art. 5 Requirements for Scholarships renewal

Scholarship will be granted for the following years of the Degree Course in Medicine and Surgery if the candidate:

- Maintains an average of grade of 27/30.
- Completes a minimum annual number of University credits (CFU) as specified in the table below (Table 3).

TABLE 3

Degree course in Medicine and Surgery	CFU Required
1 th year scholarship	According the procedure specified above
2 nd year scholarship	51, to be acquired within 1 th year
3 rd year scholarship	86, to be acquired within 2 nd year
4 th year scholarship	162, to be acquired within 3 rd year
5 th year scholarship	219, to be acquired within 4 th year
6 th year scholarship	269, to be acquired within 5 th year

- Awarded student must complete the required CFU within the month of September (last exams term of the academic year).
- In case the student will not match the CFU requirements of Table 1, the scholarship will be withdrawn and the student should pay the full amount of tuition fees starting from the following academic year.
- Awarded student is expected to complete the Degree Course in Medicine and Surgery within 6 years. However, for the purpose of the present call, an extra time of 6 months is granted for the completion of the Degree Course. After that, the scholarship will be withdrawn and the student should pay the full amount of tuition fees for the extra years.
