Travel Grant Projects

Students Travel grant projects

Travel Grants are aimed at funding thesis, research or clerkships projects abroad.

Students will be considered eligible from the 2nd year.

Projects can be developed by students with foreign institutions directly or proposed to students by Humanitas University Professors. In the latter case students can be requested to meet further requirement concerning the academic career.

How to apply

Interested Students should present a short summary of the project to the President of the Degree Course including name, surname, number id, degree course, year, project title, description and website of the host institution, description of the project

A commission of professors will evaluate the merit and quality of the project. After the evaluation, the Commission will decide whether the project has the merit to be funded or not.

Students are required to send project summaries from April 14th to May 12th at www.hunimed.eu/travel-grant-application

Selection of students

If the number of admitted projects will exceed the available funds, Travel Grants funds will be allocated to students according rules as follows:

- students of the higher year will be considered first.
- students participating for the first time will be considered prior to students already assigned with travel grants fund in the previous academic years
- grades and CFU acquired will be considered if a further selection among students is needed.

Documents to be provided before leaving

Students must provide the international Student Office with the letter (or official email) of acceptance issued by the foreign Institution. Projects without an acceptance letter will be disqualified.

Allowance

Selected students will be entitled of fixed allowance whose amount is related to the country where the project will take place. The amounts of the allowance are reported in Table 1.

The allowance will be paid after the completion of the project on the basis of:

- certificate of staying released by the hosting institution;
