

# CALL FOR APPLICATIONS FOR EU AND NON-EU STUDENTS WISHING TO TRANSFER TO THE 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>th</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> YEAR OF THE ONE CYCLE DEGREE COURSE IN MEDICINE AND SURGERY IN ENGLISH AT HUMANITAS UNIVERSITY

# Admittance to the Degree Program is subject to selection through the University Transfer Procedure

# Art. 1 Number of places available

- 2<sup>nd</sup> year, 4 (four) places currently available
- 3<sup>rd</sup> year, 7 (seven) places currently available
- 4<sup>th</sup> year, 7 (seven) place currently available.

Additional places may become available if there are further withdrawals.

\*HU will consider transferring students to the 4<sup>th</sup> year only if:

- their study program closely matches with HU one
- they have good command of Italian language
- they have acquired the essential professional skills required to go into the 4<sup>th</sup> year.

HU does not accept applications for the 5<sup>th</sup> or 6<sup>th</sup> year. Admission to the first year is exclusively granted through the admission test.

# Art. 2 Requirements Incoming degree course

HU will consider applications only if the incoming degree is in Medicine.

The incoming University and its Medical Program must be fully recognized in the Country where the incoming University is legally established in order to be considered for the transfer.

# Credits and program content match

To be eligible to transfer to:

• THE SECOND YEAR

Students must have achieved at least 80% of the number of credits corresponding to the disciplines of the first year of HU study plan with the exception of the disciplines of the course "Being a Medical Doctor".

# Students should refer to study plan 2021/22.

• THE THIRD YEAR

Students must have achieved all the credits of the first year with the exception of the disciplines of the course "Being a Medical Doctor" and all the credits of the disciplines of the second year with the exception of the disciplines included in the courses "Mechanism of Diseases I", "Mechanism of Diseases II", and "Molecular Medicine and Computational Biology"

The exams related to the disciplines included in the following exams must have passed

- Building Bodies: from gametes to organs
- Body architecture
- The cell: molecules and processes
- Principles of the living matter
- The cell: function and control
- Body at Work 1
- Body at work 2

# • THE FOURTH YEAR

Students must have achieved all the credits of the disciplines of the first year, all the credits of the disciplines of the second year and at least 80% of the of the number of credits corresponding to the disciplines of the third year of HU study plan. Also, professional skills of the third year should have been acquired to access the 4<sup>th</sup> year (see table below).

## Professional skills required to have access to the 4th year

Basic skills in traditional history taking and in writing a medical report with a specific focus on nephrological, cardiological, pneumological and haematological patient

Basic level of confidence in performing the basic steps of clinical examination of urinary, cardiovascular, pulmonary and haematological system, of the ear, nose, throat and mouth, of the breast and lymph nodes

Interpretation of EEG with a basic level of confidence

Perform and interpret blood gas analysis with a basic level of confidence

## Students should refer to study plan 2020/21

It is important that transfer students specify the number of clock hours corresponding to each of their incoming credits. The term "clock hours" means the time spent in medical school in lectures and laboratory work, excluding the fraction of credits devoted to personal study.

A slight credit/clock hour deficit may be accepted if the study programs closely match in content. In such cases, once the student is admitted, an additional evaluation may be requested for a limited number of subjects in order to be granted access to the specific examinations of the admission year.

### Language requirements

- good command of English is required: a language assessment test will be conducted by means of an interview.
- Non-Italian students must be able to speak Italian from the beginning of the third year when the professionalizing activities begin; a language assessment test will be conducted by means of an interview.



# **Candidate evaluation**

A ranking list will be generated after the evaluation of all admission requirements. The ranking list will also take into account the score of exams taken. The students in the top of the ranking could be invited in an interview with the Dean of the Medical School.

Candidates will be also required to upload the following documents:

- ID or Passport\*
- Curriculum Vitae\*
- ID/Passport\*
- Motivational Letter\*
- Current Study plan\*
- Transcript of Records
- Syllabi of exams successfully completed\*
- English/Italian Language Certificate (if any)

### Art. 3 Applications

# Candidates can apply from June 15<sup>h</sup> to July 31<sup>th</sup> 2023. Applications must be made through Humanitas University website <u>transfer.hunimed.eu</u>

### Art. 4 Application fee

Application fee is set at € 150 and must be paid online on completing the application form.

Application fee is for no reason refundable

### Art. 5 – Credit recognition

The University Teaching Council will evaluate the number and type of incoming credits of the candidates and the content match of their curriculum with Humanitas University study program.

### Art. 6 – Publication of the admission results list

The admission results will be published on Humanitas University website by September 18<sup>th</sup>, 2023.

Should other places become available after **September 18**<sup>h</sup>, further admissions will be granted following the admission results list.

Admitted students must arrive at Humanitas University for the beginning of the academic year:

- 2nd year; September 29<sup>th</sup>
- 3rd and 4<sup>th</sup> year; September 25<sup>th</sup> 2023 | professionalizing activities September 27<sup>th</sup>
