

# **Italian Courses and activities: Medicine and Surgery**

### Year 1

**Induction starter course:** 40-hour basic general Italian course held in September, both online and face-to-face with books and e-books.

**General and Medical Italian:** 16-hour courses\*(A1+/A2- levels), Semester I and II, for a total of 32 hours (with 1 elective credit each semester). Structured courses with specialised programme and on-line modules of Medical Italian, test every semester to monitor progress.

## Year 2

**General and Medical Italian:** 16-hour courses\* (A2/A2+ level), Semester I and II, for a total of 32 hours (with 1 elective credit each semester). Structured courses with specialised programme with a strong focus on Medical Italian to prepare for clerkships. Test every semester to monitor progress.

### Year 3

**General and Medical Italian:** 12-hour courses\* (A2+/B1+ Level), Semester I and II, for a total of 24 hours. Structured courses with specialised programme and on demand modules with a strong focus on Medical Italian to prepare for clerkships. Test every semester to monitor progress.

# Extra Italian activities

**On-demand course**: 20-hour on demand basic Italian course available online on Edu platform, for late incoming international students or to support students who have difficulties with Italian.

**Speaking and Culture classes:** monthly meetings open to Medical and MedTec students of all years. In small groups, in-person only.

**On-demand support course**: 10-hour course (A1-A2 level), Semester II, for students who fall behind with Italian to revise and practise content of Year 1 and 2 courses. In small groups, in-person only.

**PLIDA Certification**: 15-hour preparation course during II Semester to prepare for PLIDA international certification (currently B1-B2 level).

**Open badge system** – awarded to students on achieving a specific level of Italian (available for some courses).

**Electronic Portfolio** – available for students to monitor their progress in Italian.

**E-tandem** – language exchange project among students of HUNIMED.
