

## **Italian Courses and activities: Medicine and Surgery**

### Year 1

**Induction starter course:** 30/40-hour basic general Italian course held in September, both online and face-to-face with books and e-books.

**General and Medical Italian:** 16-hour courses (A1+/A2- levels), Semester I and II, for a total of 32 hours (with 1 elective credit each semester). Structured courses with specialised programme and on-line modules of Medical Italian, test every semester to monitor progress.

#### Year 2

**General and Medical Italian:** 16-hour courses (A2/A2+ level), Semester I and II, for a total of 32 hours (with 1 elective credit each semester). Structured courses with specialised programme with a strong focus on communication. Test every semester to monitor progress.

## Year 3

General and Medical Italian: Medical Italian tutorials.

# Extra Italian activities

**On-demand course**: 20-hour on demand basic Italian course available online on <u>Edu platform</u> and the <u>LMS platform</u>, for late incoming international students or to support students who have difficulties with Italian.

Speaking and support classes, peer-to-peer with Italian students: available on demand.

B1 (intermediate) online course: 10-hour course, Semester I and Semester II.

**PLIDA Certification**: 12-hour preparation course during II Semester to prepare for PLIDA international certification (currently B1-B2 level).

**Electronic Portfolio** – available for students to monitor their progress in Italian.

**E-tandem** – language exchange project among students of HUNIMED.
