



### **Italian Courses and activities: Medicine and Surgery**

#### **Year 1**

**Induction starter course:** 30-hour basic general Italian course held in September, both online and face-to-face with books and e-books.

#### **Year 1 and 2**

**General and Medical Italian:** two 16-hour courses (A1 and A2 levels) in person each semester. Structured courses of general Italian and on-line short modules of Medical Italian available, test every semester to monitor progress. 75% percent of attendance and the passing of the final test are required to receive 1 elective credit in each course.

#### **Year 2 and 3**

**Medical Italian:** workshops of Medical language and to practice the language for the history taking lab.

### **Extra Italian activities**

**On-demand course:** 20-hour on demand basic Italian course available online on [Edu platform](#) and the [LMS platform](#), for late incoming international students or to support students who have difficulties with Italian.

**B1 (intermediate) online course:** 10-hour course, Semester I and Semester II.

**PLIDA online preparation course:** 12-hour course to prepare for PLIDA international certification (B1 or B2 level).

**General Italian B1-C1 modules** (upper-intermediate-advanced grammar, vocabulary and text inputs) available on the LMS platform in the page “Italian as a Foreign Language”

**Speaking and support classes, peer-to-peer with Italian students:** available on demand.
