Travel Grant Projects – destination: non-European partner institutions

ART. 1 – SUBJECT

Announcement of a selection procedure for the award of International Mobility Grants from Humanitas University Travel Grant funds, aimed at supporting training activities abroad at Partner Institutions.

ART. 2 – SELECTION ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Humanitas University students enrolled in at least the 4th year of the following Degree Programmes are eligible for selection:

- Medicine & Surgery;
- MEDTEC School.

Students must meet the following requirements:

1. Having completed all the exams in the study plan up until the end of the 1° semester 2024/2025;
2. Being up to date with university fees;
3. Not having won an Erasmus+ call for applications for the same internship project.

Students must check any requirements from the host institution, such as medical certificates of good health and vaccination certificates, certified language proficiency, visa procedures, etc.

ART. 3 – APPLICATION SUBMISSION CRITERIA

Applications must be submitted via the MyPortal reserved area, menu item 'International Mobility', **by March 31st 2025**, under penalty of exclusion.

Applicants may indicate two options from those proposed in Attachment 1 of this announcement and, if no units are listed, propose two options to be verified with the partner. If no unit is listed, please mention the two options in the motivation letter.

The student will need to submit the following documentation:

1. CV in English;
2. Motivation letter, specifying the reasons why the student is interested in the two chosen units;
3. Copy of the passport.

The University assumes no responsibility for cases of non-delivery or late delivery of applications attributable to IT mishaps, third party acts, fortuitous events or force majeure.

Humanitas University reserves the right to carry out appropriate checks regarding the content of the statements made or to request additional documentation.

ART. 4 – SELECTION FOR DESTINATIONS IDENTIFIED BY THE CANDIDATES

The selection is run taking into consideration the following criteria

1. Weighted average grade;
2. Students from higher years will be considered first;
3. Students participating for the first time will be considered before students already awarded Travel Grants in previous academic years;
4. The match between requested departments/units and the actual availability is run by local partners. It might take up to 2 months to approve/refuse the mobility according to arrival dates proposed by the students.

ART. 5 – MOBILITY PERIOD

1. Mobility must take place during breaks in non-teaching periods, and last at least 3 weeks. The educational project must be completed by March 31st 2026;
2. During the mobility period, students must continue to fulfil their duties towards Humanitas University and may not be excused from any curricular or training activities.

ART. 6 – MOBILITY GRANT

Travel Grants are intended as a lump-sum contribution towards additional mobility costs. Hosting universities might ask for attendance fee and minor fees for the administration of the request. These grants are not intended to cover the full cost of the placement period abroad. For those partners that require a fee, the grant will be increased as shown below. The amount of the aid is established according to the following table:

The reimbursement must be requested by the applicant, one month before departure, using the following online form <https://www.hunimed.eu/reimbursement-claim-form>.

Humanitas University provides students with an AON insurance policy for the period abroad. It will be activated upon receipt of the reimbursement form.
