

**CALL FOR APPLICATIONS FOR EU AND NON-EU STUDENTS
WISHING TO TRANSFER TO THE 2nd, 3rd and 4th YEAR OF THE
ONE CYCLE DEGREE COURSE IN MEDICINE AND SURGERY IN
ENGLISH AT HUMANITAS UNIVERSITY**

Academic year 2026/27

Admittance to the Degree Course is subject to selection through the University Transfer Procedure.

Art. 1 - Number of places available

- 2nd year, **6 places** currently available;
- 3rd year, **7 places** currently available;
- 4th year, **8 places** currently available*.

Additional places may become available if further withdrawals occur.

*HU will consider transferring students to the 4th year only if:

- their study program closely matches with HU one;
- they have good command of Italian language (equivalent to B2 level);
- they have acquired the essential professional skills required to go into the 4th year (please see art. 2).

HU does not accept applications for the 5th or 6th year. Admission to the first year is exclusively granted through the admission test.

Art. 2 - Requirements

2.1. Degree course:

HU will consider applications only if the applicant is attending a degree course in Medicine.

The University attended by the applicant and its Medical Program must be fully recognized in the Country where the University is legally established.

2.2. Language requirements:

A good command of English is required for all candidates: a language assessment test may be conducted by means of an interview.

Non-Italian students must be able to speak Italian from the beginning of the third year when the professionalizing activities begin: a language assessment test may be conducted by means of an interview.

2.3. Credits and program content match

HU Medical School study plan (valid from the A.Y. 2021/22) and the syllabi of the courses can be found at the following link: <https://www.hunimed.eu/course/medicine/program-structure/>
The syllabi can be opened clicking on the name of the courses – i.e. click “Principles of the Living Matter” to open the relevant syllabus.

To be eligible to transfer to:

➤ THE SECOND YEAR

Students must have achieved at least **80%** of the number of credits corresponding to the disciplines of the first year of the “Study Plan A.Y 2021/22” with the exception of the disciplines of the course “Being a Medical Doctor” and the Professionalising Activities.

➤ THE THIRD YEAR

Students must have achieved:

- all the credits of the first year with the exception of the disciplines of the course “Being a Medical Doctor” and the Professionalising Activities;
- all the credits of the second year with the exception of the disciplines included in the courses “Mechanism of Diseases I”, “Mechanism of Diseases II”, “Molecular Medicine and Computational Biology” and the Professionalising Activities.

The exams related to the disciplines included in the following exams must have been passed:

- Building Bodies: from gametes to organs
- Body architecture
- The cell: molecules and processes
- Principles of the living matter

- The cell: function and control
- Body at Work 1
- Body at work 2

➤ THE FOURTH YEAR

Students must have achieved:

- all the credits of the first year;
- all the credits of the second year;
- at least 80% of the number of credits corresponding to the disciplines of the third year;

Students must have also acquired the professional skills listed in the box below:

- Basic skills in traditional history taking and in writing a medical report with a specific focus on nephrological, cardiological, and pneumological patient;
- Basic level of confidence in performing the basic steps of clinical examination of urinary, cardiovascular, pulmonary and haematological system, of the ear, nose, throat and mouth, of the breast and lymph nodes;
- Interpretation of EEG with a basic level of confidence;
- Perform and interpret blood gas analysis with a basic level of confidence.

Art. 3 Applications

Candidates can apply from **June 22nd** to **July 22nd 2026**.

Applications must be submitted through the following link of the Humanitas University website: transfer.hunimed.eu

During the online application process candidates will be required to upload the following documents:

- ☐ ID or Passport;
- ☐ Curriculum Vitae;
- ☐ Motivational Letter;
- ☐ Complete study plan from first to last year;
- ☐ Transcript of Records;
- ☐ Syllabi of exams successfully completed;
- ☐ English/Italian Language Certificate (if any);

- ❑ Clock Hours for each passed exam (The term “clock hours” means the time spent in medical school in lectures and laboratory work).
- ❑ Only for the 4th year: upload professional skills documentation at section “Attached Documents” under “other”.

Transcripts and syllabi must be official documents which have been issued by the current University.

Documents must be submitted in Italian or English Language.

Description of the main documents required

Transcript Of Records

It is the official list of exams taken at the current university. The document includes the name of the exam, date of the exam, course credits, grade obtained. To obtain it you may contact the Student Office or download the online version (if provided).

Study Plan

It is a document which lists all the exams and educational activities that must be completed during the entire course of study to obtain the final Degree Diploma.

Syllabus

It is the detailed content of each subject taught in the course of study, in which the Professor makes explicit the objectives and contents of the course. It specifies in detail the topics of the lectures, the teaching materials and the criteria of evaluation.

3.1. Procedure

1. **Online registration on the portal** (<https://transfer.hunimed.eu/auth/login>): the candidate must register by entering their name, surname, and email address. Upon completion of the registration process, an email containing a verification link will be sent to the email address provided. Candidates must confirm their account by following the instructions in the email;
2. **Create a new application:** after completing the registration on the portal, the candidate must create a new application within the indicated deadlines by entering all of the requested personal data and information on the current University;
3. **Declare the exams taken and upload their documentation:** In the “Declare Exam” section, candidates will find the list of courses included in the Humanitas University Medical School study plan ([A.Y. 2021/22](#)). For each Humanitas University course, candidates must

upload the syllabus of the previously completed examination that they wish to submit for credit recognition purposes.¹²

Candidates are strongly encouraged to upload each syllabus as a separate PDF file. Where a syllabus covers multiple courses, modules, or subjects, **candidates must clearly indicate in the file name the page numbers containing the content relevant to the corresponding Humanitas University course** (e.g., “Syllabus_Chemistry_pages_7-10”).

The submitted syllabi must be as detailed as possible in order to facilitate the assessment of the correspondence between the candidate’s previous coursework and the Humanitas University study plan.

Each syllabus will be assessed exclusively with reference to the Humanitas University course under which it has been uploaded. If the content of a submitted syllabus is deemed not to correspond to the relevant Humanitas University course, it will not be reassigned or considered for the evaluation of any other course, even where a potential correspondence may exist.

Applications containing incomplete, incorrect, illegible, unsuitable, or improperly uploaded documentation (including documents submitted in the wrong section of the application portal) will be considered inadmissible and will not be evaluated.

Art. 4 Application fee

Application fee is € 150 and must be paid online on completing the application form.

Application fee is for no reason refundable.

¹ It is possible that a course included in the Humanitas University Medical School study plan corresponds to one or more courses completed at the candidate's current university, or viceversa. In such cases, candidates are encouraged to upload all syllabi that they believe may be relevant for the assessment of equivalence.

² Only the exams that have been successfully completed and officially recorded in the Transcript of Records by the indicated deadline will be considered for the purposes of this Transfer Call.

Art. 5 Evaluation of the applications

The University Teaching Council will assess all eligible applications and determine the candidates who may be admitted on the basis of the following criteria:

- the number of credits previously obtained by the candidate;
- the correspondence between the content of the candidate's previous studies and the curriculum of the Humanitas University Degree Programme;
- the grades obtained in the exams previously completed.

Candidates who are deemed eligible following the academic evaluation may be invited to attend an interview with the Dean of the Medical School. Interviews, if required, will take place online in September.

Art. 6 Publication of the candidates accepted for transfer

The list of the accepted candidates will be published on Humanitas University website by:

- 3rd and 4th year: September 16th, 2026.
- 2nd year: September 23rd, 2026

Candidates who are not included in the list will not have the possibility to transfer.

The decisions of the University Teaching Council are final and unappealable.

Admitted students must arrive at Humanitas University for the beginning of the academic year:

- 2nd year; September 30th, 2026; lessons
- 3rd year; September 24th, 2026; White Coat Ceremony | September 25th, 2026; lessons
- 4th year; September 25th, 2026; lessons and professionalizing activities

Art. 7 Online enrolment procedures

Accepted candidates will receive an admission email from info@hunimed.eu and must complete the enrolment procedure on the University's MyPORTAL, following the instructions provided in the email.
